Dear Parents or Guardians:

On Thursday, February 6, 2025 your child will have the opportunity to participate in an after school ski trip to Shawnee Mt., Pennsylvania. We will leave Hunterdon Preparatory School at 1:30 p.m., ski and snowboard at Shawnee Mt. and return to the school by 9:00 p.m. **Students will need to be picked up by 9:00 from the Hunterdon Preparatory School.**

Transportation to Shawnee Mt. will be supplied by Hunterdon Prep. We will not be stopping for dinner on this trip, so students will need to bring either: a) some money to buy dinner at Shawnee Mt., b) bring a bag dinner or, c) purchase a "Grab& Go" meal. The Hunterdon Preparatory School will supply a cooler to store any bag dinners.

We have attached an itemized price list for the ski/snowboard activity, as well as a detailed checklist of items that all students will need in order to safely and successfully participate on the ski/snowboard trip.

Waivers must be signed by all students and their parents/guardians regardless of whether they are renting equipment or not.

*For students requiring prescription medication during the trip, medication(s) **must** be delivered to the school nurse, principal, and/or designee **AT LEAST THREE DAYS PRIOR TO THE EVENT**. It must be in a pharmacy container labeled with the name of the student and physician, the name of the medicine, dosage, and times to be taken.
