Dear Parents/Guardians:

Our Halloween celebration is Monday, October 31, 2016. The parade will begin at 2:00 p.m. Our students are anxiously waiting for this exciting day. Participation on the part of students is voluntary. Unless the teacher receives a note to the contrary, it will be assumed that a student has parental permission to participate in these activities. Children are <u>not</u> to wear their costumes to school. All students will change into their costumes after lunch period. Fifth grade helpers will be on-hand to help younger children dress. We will be having a regular day of school until it's time for the festivities.

We ask that parents follow three guidelines in selecting a costume for their child. Any costume that includes items replicating weapons (ex: guns, knives, swords, grenades, etc.) will not be permitted. In addition, we ask parents not to have their child wear a costume which may be considered offensive to any ethnic or religious group.

Cooper Halloween activities will begin at 2:00, and end at 3:00 p.m. Please be reminded of the Elementary School Party Guidelines that are in place for the 2016-2017 school year, which can be found online in the Elementary School Handbook.
