Monday, June 15th, 2020 – Volz School Reverse 8th Grade Parade

On Friday, June 19th from 9:00 – 11:00 AM we are going to ask students to come to school and exchange their Chromebook and any other school owned items. - When parents arrive we will use the sign with your child's name on it to identify them. We will retrieve the items and place it in the car. No parent or child should exit their car at any time.
