Dear 8th Grade Parent/Guardian:

Welcome to Morris Hills Regional District's online registration portal designed to pre-register your student(s) in school. This letter is intended to introduce you to the process and platform. **The registration portal will open December 10, 2024, and the registration process should be completed no later than February 3, 2025.** Delays in registration may impact the availability of elective courses, the scheduling of transportation, and athletic participation for your student.

Students who live in Denville, Rockaway Borough, Rockaway Township, or Wharton must register with Morris Hills Regional using our online platform if they plan on attending Morris Hills, Morris Knolls, Morris County Vocational School District (for tuition and transportation), or a private/parochial school (for transportation or aid in lieu of transportation).

Important Reminders:

- Only a parent, court-appointed guardian, or legal-aged student may complete the online enrollment process.
- You are legally obligated to provide accurate information during the registration process.
- You are responsible for maintaining your online portal password. If your password is ever compromised, you
 must change it immediately.
- Prior to enrolling, all new students will have their addresses verified with the street address map and/or tax records.

- This process can be done on any computer or device with Internet access. If you are using a phone, be sure to click on "request desktop access" when viewing the Aspen website on a mobile device.
- You can save your work and return at a later time to complete the process.
- You will also be asked to submit a copy of the student's birth certificate and documents to prove residency in the
 district. If you are unable to provide the necessary documents online you can schedule a required meeting with

MORRIS HILLS REGIONAL DISTRICT IN-DISTRICT SCHOOL CHOICE LOTTERY PROGRAM

FOR 8TH-GRADE STUDENTS INTERESTED IN SWITCHING HIGH SCHOOLS

Fourteen years ago, the Morris Hills Regional District Board of Education approved the creation of a school choice lottery for students residing in Denville, Rockaway Borough, Rockaway Township, or Wharton who may wish to attend an MHRD high school other than the one designated by their residence. The lottery was created in response to community concerns over the social impact of having two high schools.

For most years of the lottery's existence, approximately half of the applicants have requested a switch from Knolls to Hills, and the other half from Hills to Knolls.

Please note that both of our high schools follow the same curriculum and are ranked among the top schools in New Jersey.

The district will make up to 15 "choice" seats available for the 2025-2026 school year. Students who apply for and are selected for the lottery may choose to attend either Morris Hills or Morris Knolls High Schools, regardless of their residence within the four sending communities.

The program is not available to students who are already enrolled in grades 9-12 or who live outside the district.

Families who are interested in participating in the lottery must do the following:

- 1) Register with the Morris Hills Regional District at the school indicated by your address.
- Once your registration and proofs of residency have been accepted, you will receive a confirmation email with a link to the online lottery application. This year's application must be <u>submitted</u> by <u>February 3</u>, <u>2025</u>.
