Dear Parents / Guardians,

Beginning Tuesday, 1/19/21, hybrid students will be returning to school. In an effort to improve student learning, staff will now be live streaming their lessons from school from Monday through Thursday each day. This means that whether the student is in-school or virtual they will be receiving live instruction. Staff and students will be expected to follow their "in-school" schedule for all classes Monday through Thursday. During these classes, our staff will deliver a synchronous learning experience. For example, if your child has ELA from 9:50am to 10:40am, they should be live virtually with their ELA teacher for the entire 50 minutes. If your child does not attend their classes in-person or virtually, they will be marked absent and it may affect their overall grade. Friday will be an asynchronous learning day with staff providing support where they see fit, and students do not need to follow their schedule. If a student cannot be present during any class, please reach out to the teacher. When students have periods such as lunch and Hawk Time, they can use this as a break or independent work time. If you need your child's daily schedule, please refer to the parent or student portal. Preschool parents will receive a daily schedule from their child's teacher. Please see the period times for the 4th through 8th grade students below.
