






- Doors open at 8:15 & close at 8:30 AM for morning arrival
- We recommend arriving to the school between 8:15 8:20 AM.
- All students are dismissed by staff members at the conclusion of each day starting at approximately 2:55 PM. Please be patient and flexible. Students are dismissed one at a time. Safety is a top priority.
- If you need before or after care, please see our <u>website</u>.
- Weather permitting, the students go out for recess every day.
- We conduct two drills per month (fire and security). Parents will get an email by the conclusion of the school day to inform them that a security drill was completed. We work closely with the Runnemede Police Department to monitor and evaluate or safety practices.

- Social Emotional Learning: Every morning at 9:00 AM and integrated throughout the school day #bucketfilling
- Language Arts: "The Daily 5", Reading, Writing,
 Spelling, Social Studies, and Science
- Mathematics: "The Daily 3"
- Specials (Music, STEAM, Health, Physical Education, World Language, & Art) The students also visit the school library on a regular basis.
- Kindergarten & 1st Grade Lunch & Recess 11:05-11:55 AM
- 2nd & 3rd Grade Lunch and Recess 12:05-1:00 PM








Greetings from Nurse Feldman & Nurse Shapiro:


