

As we enter the fall season, we want to share a quick look at the upcoming October events at our elementary schools.

Each year during the first week of October, schools across the country celebrate the **Week of Respect**. Schools provide age-appropriate instruction that focuses on preventing and remediating harassment, intimidation, and bullying. As part of the celebration, students are allowed to dress up in the following themes each day.

Monday, October 4th: United We Stand Against Bullying: Students may wear a red, white, and/or blue shirt with their uniform bottoms.

<u>Tuesday, October 5th</u>: Be A Force For Kindness: Students may wear a Star Wars themed shirt or yellow and black top with their uniform bottoms.

<u>Wednesday, October 6th</u>: Being A Friend Is No Sweat: Students may wear their favorite sweatshirt with their uniform bottoms.

<u>Thursday, October 7th</u>: Let's Keep The Peace: Students may draw a picture of how they show kindness toward one another.

<u>Friday. October 8th</u>: Spirit Day: Students may wear any Huber Street School/Secaucus shirt with their uniform bottoms.

<u>Thursday, October 28th</u>: We Scare Drugs Away: Students may wear an orange, black, or Halloween shirt with their uniform bottoms
